

About approval of the rules for admission to master's programs of higher educational institutions of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the National Academy of Sciences of Azerbaijan"

**RESOLUTION ABOUT THE CABINET OF MINISTERS OF THE  
REPUBLIC OF AZERBAIJAN**

To ensure the implementation of paragraph 2.3 of the Decree of the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan dated December 21, 2016 No. 1168 "On Amendments to the Decree No. 156 of the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan dated september 5, 2009, on the Application of the Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan "On Education" and based on the proposal of the State Examination Center of the Republic of Azerbaijan, the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Azerbaijan decides:

1. "Approve rules for admission to master's programs of higher educational institutions of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the National Academy of Sciences of Azerbaijan " (attached).
2. Cancel the decision of the State Commission on student admission of the Republic of Azerbaijan dated December 2011, 29 No. 1, which was abolished" on approval of the rules for admission to master's programs of higher educational institutions of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the National Academy of Sciences of Azerbaijan".

## **Admission to the Master's program of higher education institutions of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Azerbaijan National Academy of Sciences**

### **Rules**

#### **1. General provisions**

1.1. These rules have been prepared following articles 26.4 and 26.6 of the law of the Republic of Azerbaijan "On Education" and define the rules for admission of bachelors and other persons with higher education to master's programs of state, municipal, and private higher education institutions operating following the relevant legislation of the Republic of Azerbaijan.

1.2. Bachelors and other persons with higher education (hereinafter - bachelors) have the right to enter the magistracy of higher educational institutions and a scientific organization.

1.3. Education in the magistracy is carried out based on a state order (at the expense of the state budget) or on a paid basis.

1.4. The state guarantees the right of students to study for free only once, following the legislation at the magistracy level of Higher Education.

1.5. Admission to master's degrees, except for the cases provided for in Article 26.5 of the Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan "On Education", based on the results obtained by the bachelor in the exam (admission exam) on the assessment of knowledge in the relevant academic year, the State Examination Center of the Republic of Azerbaijan (hereinafter - the Center) is carried out through the competition.

1.6. Undergraduates studying at higher educational institutions and a scientific organization (except for those studying at graduation courses) cannot participate in the competition for admission to the magistracy.

1.7. Participation in the competition is paid.

#### **2. Acceptance of applications**

2.1. To participate in the competition for admission to the magistracy of higher educational institutions and a scientific organization, bachelors must fill out the "electronic application of The Bachelor" on the official website of the Center. All bachelors who graduated from higher education institutions located in the Republic of Azerbaijan and are citizens of the Republic of Azerbaijan must fill out the "Bachelor's electronic application" on the official website of the Center and confirm it themselves. Other bachelors must confirm their application by personally submitting the original documents to the document acceptance commissions established by the Center (from now on CEC):

2.1.1. Citizens of the Republic of Azerbaijan shall receive their identity cards, passports, and (or) permit cards of foreigners, documents or permits issued to stateless persons to travel outside the borders of their country of residence, identity cards of stateless persons permanently residing in the Republic of Azerbaijan, persons who have received refugee status and their families. members refugee cards, travel documents issued to them, other documents or permission cards in the cases stipulated by international agreements;

2.1.2. document on higher education and its annex;

2.1.3. documents confirming recognition of higher education qualifications of foreign states issued by the Ministry of Science and Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan to persons having higher education in foreign countries.

2.2. Foreigners and persons educated in foreign countries, along with the documents mentioned in paragraph 2.1 of these rules, submit a notarized translation of these documents into Azerbaijani to the CEC.

3.1. The master's degree entrance examination is conducted centrally by the Center in two stages:

3.1.1. exam for evaluating the bachelor's general intelligence level (logical thinking), informatics and foreign language knowledge;

3.1.2. knowledge assessment exam in specialized subjects.

Depending on the bachelor's degree, the subjects of the examination are determined by the Center in agreement with the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan based on the proposals of higher education institutions and the Azerbaijan National Academy of Sciences. Undergraduates must complete tests or written work, and those who want to be admitted to a master's degree in specializations that require special abilities must only take an aptitude test.

Bachelors who register on the official website of the Center during the period announced by the Center, participate in the aptitude test, and whose results in that exam meet the specified competition conditions, specialize in the master's degree in specialties that require special abilities (except for the journalism specialty), and master's degree specializations in journalism by the Center Undergraduates who register on the Center's official website during the announced period, get an "acceptable" grade on the aptitude test, choose the journalism program during the program selection process, and the results of the specialty exam meet the specified competition conditions can choose.

According to the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Azerbaijan No. 170 dated April 17, 2018 ("Khalq" newspaper of April 24, 2018, No. 91, Legislative Collection of the Republic of Azerbaijan, 2018, No. 4, Article 818) in subsection 6.4.3 of the "Rules for Admission to Master's Degrees of Educational Institutions and the Azerbaijan National Academy of Sciences", the word "cigarette" was replaced by the words "tobacco product".

3.1. The entrance exam for the master's degree is conducted by the Center on the assessment of the general level of intelligence (logical thinking), knowledge of Computer Science, and foreign languages of bachelors in a centralized manner.

3.2. The foreign language that the bachelor will take the exam in the entrance exam is determined by the Bachelor, taking into account the following rules and is included in the "bachelor's electronic application":

3.2.1. bachelors wishing to enroll in specializations in the Azerbaijani language can choose English, German, French, or Russian;

3.2.2. bachelors wishing to enroll in Russian-language specializations can choose English, German, or French;

3.2.3. bachelors wishing to enroll in specializations in English (German) should choose only English (German) as a foreign language;

3.2.4. bachelors wishing to enroll in the Azerbaijani language and Azerbaijani literature of the philology specialty, as well as in the Azerbaijani language of teaching history can choose also Arabic or Persian as a foreign language;

3.2.5. bachelors wishing to enroll in specializations in philology (foreign language and literature), foreign language and literature teaching, foreign language teaching and translation cannot choose the language of specialization as a foreign language;

3.2.6. bachelors who want to be admitted to Regional Studies (American Studies), Regional Studies (USA and Canada), country Studies (UK studies) should choose English as a foreign language, bachelors who want to be admitted to country studies (Germany) should choose German only, and bachelors who want to be admitted to country studies (France studies) should choose French only.

3.3. The results of the exam on the assessment of The Bachelor's general intelligence level (logical thinking), knowledge of Informatics, and foreign languages bachelors who meet the competition conditions determined by the Center in agreement with the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan are admitted to the exam on the assessment of knowledge in specialized subjects.

3.4. Bachelors who want to be admitted to the specialty master's specialties and Journalism master's specialties in specialties requiring special abilities and who meet the competition condition, the results of which are determined by the Center in agreement with the Ministry of Science and Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan, must pass the aptitude test within the period announced by the center.

3.5. The master's programs of ADA "University, the Baku branch of Moscow State University and the Military Scientific Research Institute, the Military Management Institute, the Academy of the State Border Service of the Republic of Azerbaijan, the Academy of the State Security Service of the Republic of Azerbaijan named after Heydar Aliyev and the master's programs of the Azerbaijan State Academy of Physical Culture, Bachelors wishing to be admitted to the "sports medicine and rehabilitation" specializations must pass the admission procedures established by these higher education institutions after passing the entrance exam.

3.6. The Center determines the content, form, technology of conducting exams, duration, place, and days of their conduct. The content of the exam questions is determined following the

admission programs on the exam subjects prepared by the Center and approved in agreement with the Ministry of Science and Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan.

3.7. Favorable conditions are created by the Center to ensure the participation of persons with disabilities in the entrance exams. For 81-100 percent impairment of the body's functions, bachelors with visual impairment are assigned an individual supervisor, and the duration of the exam for them is increased by 30 minutes.

#### **4. Specialization selection**

4.1. The choice of specialization for admission to the magistracy is made after the announcement of the results of the entrance and aptitude tests. Bachelors whose results in the exams for admission and aptitude for the choice of specialization correspond to the conditions of the competition determined by the Center in agreement with the Ministry of Science and Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan are allowed.

4.2. The Bachelor chooses from the specialties corresponding to the specialty he has completed, enters them in the electronic specialization selection application form in the desired sequence, and approves them. In cases provided for in the "classification of some specialties (specializations) on the master's level of Higher Education" approved by the decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Azerbaijan dated October 2011, 31 No. 177, bachelors wishing to be admitted to the master's programs of higher education institutions of special purpose are given the right to choose.

4.3. The scores obtained by bachelors who wish to be admitted to the English (German) language majors in the entrance exam in English (German) must comply with the competition conditions determined by the Center for the English (German) language majors.

4.4. Bachelors who want to be admitted to the specialization of the master's program of a scientific organization must register on the official website of the Center at the time determined by the Center before choosing a specialization and participating in an interview in that organization. Only bachelors who receive an "acceptable" grade from the interview can choose a master's specialization in a scientific organization during the selection of specialization.

4.5. After passing the entrance exam, bachelors who register on the official website of the Center, participate in the aptitude test, and receive an "acceptable" grade from that exam can choose the specialization of the master's degree in specialties requiring special abilities and the specialization of the master's degree in journalism within the period announced by the Center.

4.6. The sequence of selected specializations specified in the application form is taken as the basis during the competition and, based on the score accumulated by the Bachelor, is placed in the first specialization in which he passed the competition.

#### **5. Holding the competition**

5.1. The competition on the specialties chosen by bachelors is carried out based on the total score (sum of points) obtained from the exam, which is held in two stages.

5.2. Placement of bachelors in specializations is carried out within the framework of the number of vacancies in specializations, taking into account the sequence of specializations specified by them in their applications and the forecast of admission by state order.

5.3. To distinguish between two or more bachelors with the same exam score, additional indicators are used in the following sequence:

5.3.1. overall average success indicator (OASI);

5.3.2. the score obtained from the exam on the assessment of knowledge in the specialty;

5.3.3. score from the test that checks the general level of intelligence (logical thinking) ;

5.3.4. score from the test on a foreign language.

5.4. If it is not possible to distinguish between two or more bachelors with the same exam score, they are all placed in the appropriate specialization.



5.5. After the announcement of the results of the competition, the vacant places are announced, the choice of specialization is carried out by bachelors following paragraphs 4.1-4.5 of these rules, and the placement of these places by competition is carried out.

## **6. Final provisions**

6.1. Regardless of the form of study, a bachelor placed in any specialization must register by submitting the required documents to an educational institution or scientific organization where he is admitted within 10 days. The failure of a bachelor to register in an educational institution or scientific organization during this period is regarded as a refusal to study in the specialty in which he is placed. These bachelors are not allowed to participate in the competition for vacant places.

6.2. An appeal Commission is created by the Center for Consideration of Citizens' appeals related to the competition for admission to master's degrees of higher educational institutions and a scientific organization and its results.

6.3. The Bachelor must apply to the Appeal Commission in person, presenting the original of the identity document. Decisions of the Appeal Commission can be appealed administratively or can be addressed to the court.

6.4. The Bachelor is prohibited from committing the following actions:

6.4.1. to submit a fake or someone else's document, to send someone else to the exam instead of himself;

6.4.2. bring or use mobile phones and other means of communication, calculators and other electronic devices, abstracts, dictionaries, tables, reference books, and other aids to the exam;

6.4.3. enter the exam building with incendiary, explosive, cutter, piercing, shooter, and other similar objects, bring tobacco products with him;

6.4.4. exit the exam hall regardless of the reason from the moment of the announcement of the start of the exam until the expiration of 1.5 hours (in the first stage) and 1 hour (in the second stage) and during the last 15 minutes of the exam;

6.4.5. obstruct the course of the exam by changing its location, walking, standing still, and other actions in the exam hall;

6.4.6. influencing someone else's outcome, including viewing someone else's answer card, or question book, allowing someone else to view their answer card or question book, and asking or reporting the answer to a question;

6.4.7. appeal to the supervisor or other persons for help in solving tasks;

6.4.8. damaging the answer card and the question book, and leaving the examination hall without handing them over to the supervisor.

6.5. In case of detection by the center of cases when a bachelor commits actions specified in paragraph 6.4 of these rules, his competition results are canceled. This decision can be appealed administratively or in court.
